Dear Prospective New Member,



Thank you for your interest in joining the Canterbury Land Rover Owners Club (Inc.) (CLROC). You might like to know a little more about us. Established in 1966, we are New Zealand's oldest 4WD club. In spite of our name, we are much more than a one make car club - in fact membership is open to all makes of four wheel drive vehicles with capabilities similar to the Land Rover, provided the vehicle is equipped with a low-ratio transfer box. We count a large number of Toyota Landcruisers and Hilux's, Nissan Patrols and other similar vehicles amongst our members as well as Land Rovers, Range Rovers and Discoveries - old and late model vehicles alike.

Our primary efforts are the organisation of club off-road trips, but we also provide driver education, training and safety checks and maintain quite an extensive library of books, repair manuals and videos. Once a member you will have full access to these services.

Membership currently stands at between 120 and 135 members with over 30 people attending our monthly meetings. Meetings are held on the third Tuesday of each month (except for January, which is the fourth Tuesday) at Robbies Bar and Restaurant at 87 Riccarton Road (entry and parking from Nelson St) and run from 7:30 to about 9:30pm. Our meetings are a chance for members to get together over a drink and a bite to eat. We briefly report back on what the committee has been working on but the general emphasis is on reporting on recent and forthcoming club trips and activity. We may also have slides, videos or a guest speaker

We publish a monthly digital magazine. This is entertaining and informative, and it gives details about upcoming trips and social events. It carries some advertising of 4WD-relevant products and we encourage our members to support the advertisers as they support us. This is also available in digital format through the club's website.

THERE ARE TWO TYPES OF MEMBERSHIPS.

Full Financial Membership (Individual or Family) - Criteria:

Own a suitable vehicle and are in the Canterbury region. A family membership includes other listed members of your family living at the same address.

You will have voting rights (one vote per membership); receive our digital magazine each month; have one access to the CLROC website; and all members can access the CLROC members only Facebook page.

Associate Membership - Criteria:

Do not currently own a qualifying 4WD vehicle OR are from out of the Canterbury region you may apply to join as an associate member.

You will receive our digital magazine each month; have one access to the CLROC website; and all members can access the CLROC members only Facebook page.

Associate members do not have voting rights and are unable to bring vehicles on trips – but we'll find a spare seat if there's a trip that you'd like to attend.

You may be advised to join as an associate member in the interim, if your vehicle is awaiting modification for safe tow points etc.

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MEMBERSHIP PROCESS:

A new membership process flowchart and a new membership application form is attached.

- *Please contact **the Membership Officer** they will help you select the membership option to best suit you and are available to answer any questions around the membership process.
- *Please arrange payment to our bank account. Westpac 03-0802-0095486-00
- *Complete the information in the form and return it to the Membership Officer.
- *If you're applying for a full membership you must arrange for the Safety Officer/Safety Team to complete a vehicle and equipment check. The Safety Officer/Team member must sign section 'D' on this form that your towing attachments and equipment have been checked and approved prior to your application being finalised. In the case that your vehicle does not pass the safety check e.g., requires tow point/safety improvements you will not be able to attend trips with your vehicle until it passes a recheck.
- *Please keep you form and hand to Membership officer when all completed.

The membership form requires the signature of two existing members in support of your application. If you do not already know someone in the club, you are most welcome to come along to one of our meetings and make yourself known to one of the Committee members.

Once submitted, your membership application will then be presented for consideration at the next committee meeting and the Membership Officer will be in contact with you. In the unlikely event that your application is declined, your fees will be refunded in full.

ONCE A MEMBER:

A requirement of membership is that you are familiar with the club's rules, care and use of your vehicle off the road, recovery techniques and safety. The club arranges training days, usually once a quarter, where you will learn how best to handle your vehicle off the road to ensure you have a safe trip and can cope with the kinds of obstacles and problems encountered on club trips.

As a responsible organization, we place a great deal of emphasis on both safety and the philosophy of the 'DOC NZ Care Codes'. We try to minimise the impact of our vehicles on the environment (and that sometimes means not venturing into particularly sensitive areas). Also, since our activities are highly dependent on the goodwill of landowners throughout New Zealand, we place great value on the access we enjoy as a club to private and public lands. We require members to respect the areas we travel in and always act in a way which ensures we will be welcomed back. We also require that our members respect the rights of other people we meet in the back country, especially those on foot.


